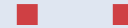
Pictured above is a copy of this month's parchment we print for our friends. It is 8.5x11 and free for you to pick up during your next visit.

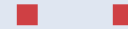
Minister: "Well, Mr. Jones is moving Saturday. I'll be sorry to see him go."
