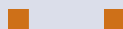
## Monthly Parchment

4:00pm	Return to camp for bullets.		

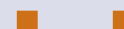
Pictured above is a copy of this month’s parchment we print for our friends. It is 8.5x11 and free for you to pick up during your next visit.

A centipede is an inchworm that has switched to the metric system.

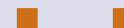

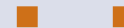

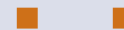
