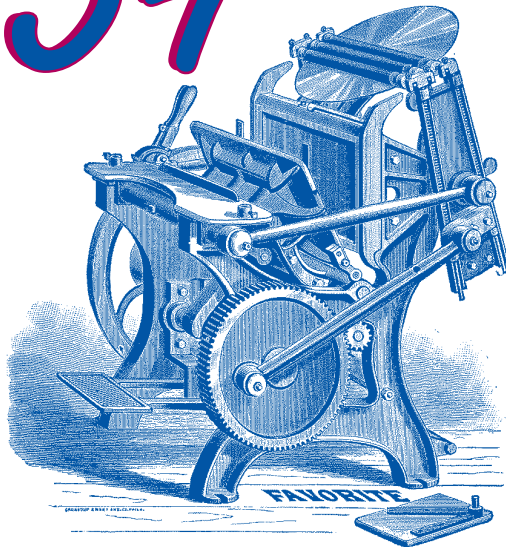

At least three thousand people keep trying to tell us how to lose weight. Unfortunately there seems to be at least three million bakeries trying to help us find it again.

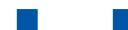
