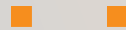
Monthly Parchment

Pictured above is a copy of this month's parchment we print for our friends. It is 8.5x11 and free for you to pick up during your next visit.

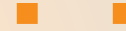

The old lady patted her white locks in place with a bewildered look.

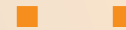
"Really," she said, "I don't know myself. I just stick a pin in the paper and, well, there it is."
